#### Looking for ways to contribute to our community?

Here is a summary of what they all are:

**WESE Board**: The Waldorf Education Society of Edmonton owns the building and runs the early childhood programming. Meetings are held on the third Thursday of the month inperson with an online option. New members will be voted in during the upcoming AGM.

**WISE Charter School Board**: Is responsible for the governance of the WISE Charter School. Meetings are held on the third Thursday of the month in-person with an online option. New members will be voted in during the first Society AGM.

**The WISE Charter School Council** presents an opportunity for parents to enrich the life of the school community by supporting school-wide events, championing the efforts of teachers, and helping fundraising initiatives. The first meeting to establish a school council will take place on **Wednesday, October 2nd** from 7:00-8:00 PM in the school gymnasium.

#### **WISE Event**

We are excited to return to Gold Bar Park and bring our traditional Pumpkin Walk to our community this year. Here is some information for everyone:

The event itself is on **Saturday, October 26th**, from 5-8 pm at Gold Bar Park Picnic Site #2.

Families purchase tickets in advance, for a specific "tour time", and embark on a sweet little walk through the forest, on a path lit by many carved pumpkins. En route, they will



encounter actors who will bring a story to life. There will be a bake and cider sale, which will be by cash donation. You will be able to gather and enjoy your treats around a large fire. Many people choose to dress up in costume for the event. It's sweet and simple and usually quite a lovely evening. It should be noted that all who attend the walk must have a ticket, including volunteers and committee members. They are only **\$5** (no ticket needed for children three years old and younger) and are purchased in advance. Tickets sell out quickly every year, and the early time slots are the first to fill. So, if you have little ones for whom a bedtime is very important, please know that you will have to get your tickets ASAP.

Because we have limited space, tickets are only available for the immediate family members of the WISE Charter School and WESE members. Your friends and extended family are invited to come to our Winter Fair on November 30th.

We hope many people are looking forward to participating! We will need the usual bevy of volunteers to make this special event work and, as a perk for helping, all volunteers get early access to tickets, the chance to buy tickets for your family at just the right time. Some of the volunteer positions needed are: actors for the play, helping out the bake sale, and helpers for set-up and clean up. If you would like to sign up and have access to advanced tickets, please ensure you're signed up by NOON on TUESDAY, OCTOBER 8th. The link will be sent out that evening. Volunteers will have a few days to buy tickets before the link is made available to everyone on SATURDAY, OCTOBER 12th. Students in classes six through nine are welcome to sign up as well; lines will have to be learned at home with family support.
